Monday 16 ADFAS Narrabri Lecture "Degas and Rodin" Mr Michael Howard MA Courtauld BA (hons) Michael is a senior lecturer in the School of History Art and Design at Manchester Metropolitan University. He is a practicing artist, painter, sculptor, printmaker and ceramicist. He has exhibited at the Royal Academy and published books on European art of the 19th and 20th century. Michael and his wife have their own gallery in Glossop. Degas and Rodin: Edgar Degas (France 1834 - 1917) - painter, printmaker and sculptor famous for his depictions of ballet and racehorses. He is an influential figure in the evolution of modern art. Auguste Rodin (France 1840 - 1917) - the greatest sculptor of his century.
