Early Days

Cuttabri—A Link with Cobb & Co

The wine shop of Cuttabri as it stands today was built on the ashes of a handsome 22 room hotel known as the "Beehive Hotel" The hotel was destroyed by fire in 1900. At that time Cuttabri was a thriving village with a blacksmith, a butcher, a general store, a school and several houses. It served a large sleeper cutting community.

Jim Graham, the Licensee at the time left after the fire and in 1903 the license was granted to James and Elizabeth Hall who rebuilt the hotel. They continued to run the hotel. In the early days the hotel was a stop-over for Cobb & Co coaches on the long trip from Narrabri to Walgett, as this was the main road to Walgett.

These coaches were the mainstay of the business as the passengers always ate and drank whilst the horses were changed over to continue the journey. IN 1915 a license for a Post Office was granted to Mrs Elizabeth Hall, so starting 55 years of continuous service by one family. After Mrs Hall's death the Post Office continued to be operated by one of her sons, Harry Hall, who continued until its closure in 1972. Harry was post master for 37 years, and one of his last official duties was to accept the following telegram: To Mr Harry Hall, Postmaster Cuttabri, I am informing you that Her Majesty, the Queen, has been pleased to bestow on you the Imperial Service Medal for long and valuable service to the Commonwealth. Warm congratulations and best wishes for your retirement. William McMahon, Prime Minister Cuttabri continues to operate as a wine shanty. As I write this it was only this year (1998) that Mrs Dowd passed away and the Dowd family are presently selling the shanty to the Fragar family of "Bulgara" it has since changed hands again.

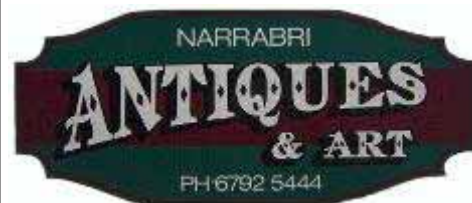
