## .Wee Waa Today

*From Back to Wee Waa Official Souvenir Price 2/-*

**28 October to 3 November 1935**

*Probably one of the biggest business concerns in the district is the saw-milling and ice works of Messrs. A. and L. Schwager's. The sawmill was first established in 1881 by the late FIL. Schwager and was between Narrabri and Wee Waa. In 1898 the plant was moved to Wee Waa by the original owner and from 1903 conducted by the present proprietors, who supply timber to all parts of the State. The ice works were established in 1928. (This spot is now Dickinson Concrete)*

*A progressive move that should have been undertaken long ago is the intention of a company to install electric light in the town. A franchise has been granted and it is anticipated a service will be available from Narrabri early next year. (being 1936)*

*Excellent tennis courts, and golf links cater for the sporting requirements of the residents.*

*The establishment of a newspaper in Wee Waa was carried out by the late J C Humphries, who came here from Collarenebri and launched the "Namoi Echo". (The name now given to the Museum he died in May 1930) This was acquired in 1929 by Mr Harold Campbell, a Western newspaper proprietor, and the name altered to "The Wee Waa Herald." The business has been held on lease by Messrs. G. Toogood, A. K. Wood, D McGilvray and D Kennedy. This month Mr Campbell disposed of his interest to Mr O B Brown, (Neil) of Coonamble, who has now taken up residence in Wee Waa and will in future control the destiny of "The Herald." (Since the time of this article the paper was taken over by Tom Brown, Neil's brother, Tom Brown ran the paper for 35 years it was called the Namoi Valley Echo, then there was the Student Echo it was printed fortnightly its final edition was in 1996, the Wee Waa Ink was started in December 1998, The Dunnett brothers of Narrabri started the Wee Waa News July 17 1991.)*

An exhibition of over thirty new works by well known Gunnedah artist, Maree Kelly.

The 12 x 16 exhibition explores the essence of the Australian landscape and in particular the north-western New South Wales area. Maree was born and raised in the area and has a strong affinity with this part of the country.

From the open plains to the hills and outcrops surrounding them, the rivers, creeks and farming country, Maree records her impressions of the diversity to be found in her environment.

The series of contemporary works are all oil paintings on small canvases measuring 12" x 16" (or 30cm x 40cm) - hence the title of the exhibition.

Maree studied Fine Arts at Newcastle University, obtaining her degree in 2000. Since then she has exhibited regularly and has been a finalist in several major art awards including the Country Energy Landscape Prize, the Cromwell's Art Prize and the Norvill Art Prize.

In May 2004, Maree was featured in the Australian Artist magazine. She has had work acquired for both the Narrabri and Gunnedah Shire Art Collections and she also has work in many private collections throughout Australia, the United Kingdom and the United States.

The Exhibition runs from 28th June - 25th July.
